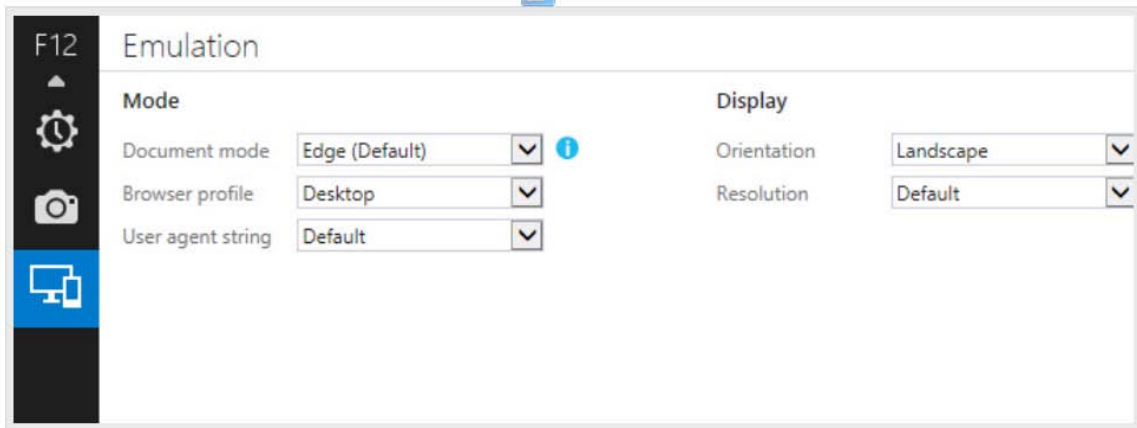


PDO SAP E-Recruitment Browser Compatibility

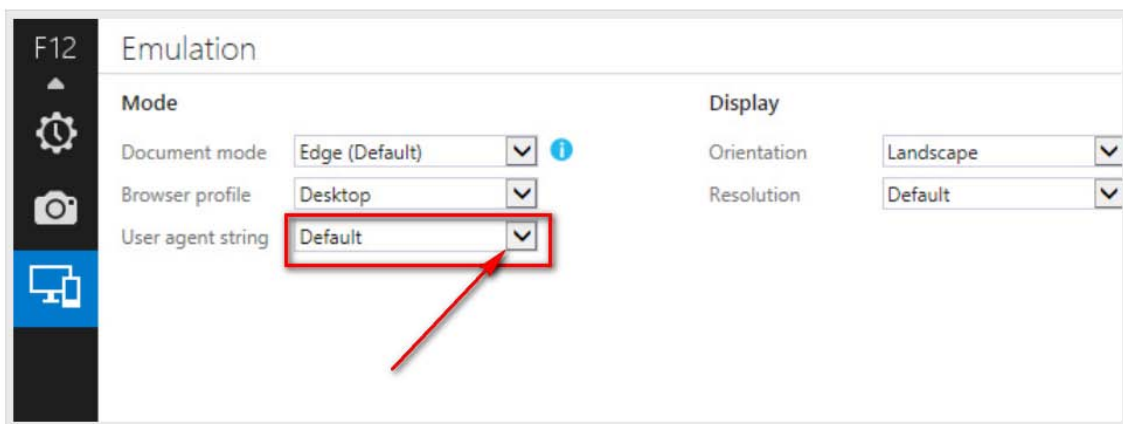
The Recruitment application is presently compatible only up to **Internet Explorer version 9**.

In case you are using a **newer Internet Explorer version** such as **10 or 11** then you will need to do the follows

1. On your internet browser hit function key F12 then CTRL-8. This will bring up the following screen



2. Click the drop down of "User agent string" as show below



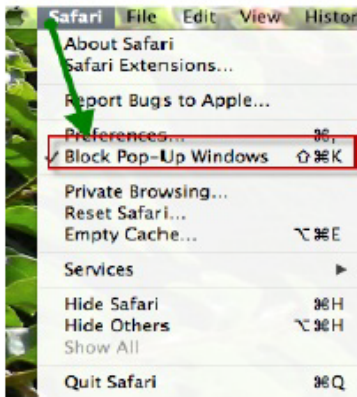
3. Select the below from the drop down



4. Now access the registration / login site.

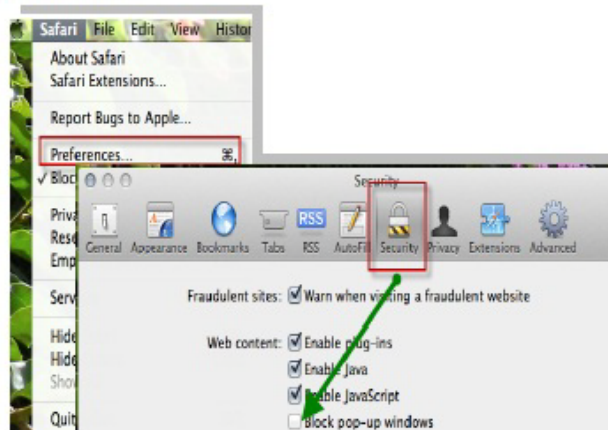
For Mac Users

Deactivation of pop-up blocker in Safari:



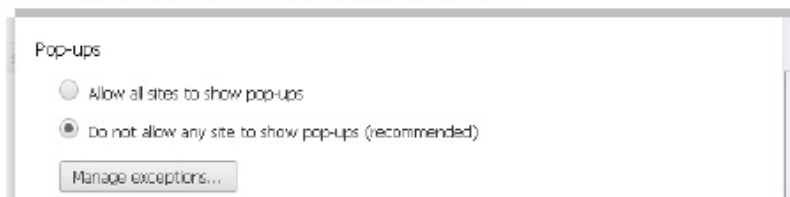
To disable pop-ups in Safari, select Safari, then Block Pop-Up Windows and deactivate (or deactivate via $\text{⌘}+\text{K}$ on your keyboard).

Alternatively, in Safari, select Preferences (or $\text{⌘}+$ via the keyboard) → Security → and disable Block pop-up windows.



- Deactivation of pop-up blocker in Google Chrome:

To allow a manual pop-up from a website, click on the  icon on the browser toolbar, select settings → show advanced settings and under privacy, click the content settings button → pop-ups, click manage exceptions.

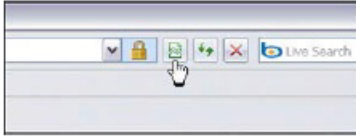


MAC Users using Internet Explorer 9 or 10 and Mozilla Firefox:

1) Do I need to do something when using Internet Explorer 9 or 10?

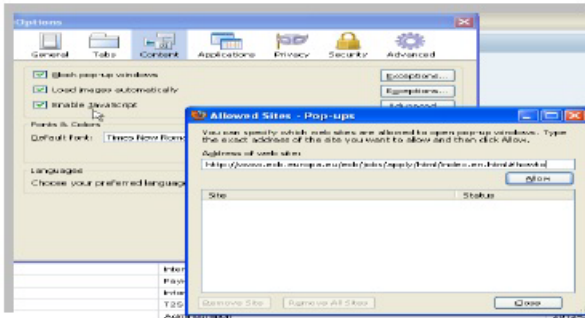
If you are using Internet Explorer 9 or 10, please make sure you click on the "compatibility" feature below:

Please check whether your pop-up blocker is deactivated. If, for example, the vacancy is not displayed, it could be related to the activated pop-up blocker.

Deactivation of pop-up blocker in Mozilla Firefox:



To disable the pop-up blocker in Firefox, go to "Tools" then "Options" and under Block pop-up windows, click on Exceptions. Copy the address of the web site and then allow.

Once your approved web site has been added to the list, you will be able to search and apply for vacancies.
